Dear Brady Parents,

Happy spring! It's hard to believe the end of the year is upon us! As we begin to prepare for the close of the 2018-19 school year, one big job ahead of us is preparing classrooms for the renovations scheduled to begin over summer break.

Given the magnitude of the work to be completed (all materials, supplies and furniture will be removed from each classroom), Dr. Campbell and the Orange Board of Education have agreed to provide members of the Brady staff additional time to pack classroom supplies and materials. This means the last day of school for Brady students will be **Wednesday, June 5**. School will be in session a full day, with the Great Race assembly to be held in the afternoon.

In a similar way, Dr. Campbell and the Board know that additional time and effort will be needed in August to prepare classrooms for the start of school. An additional half day of work time will be provided on Monday, August 19. This means the first day of school for Brady students will be **Tuesday, August 20**, and school will be in session for a full day (7:35 a.m. to 2:35 p.m.).

These changes to the calendar will not impact students from other schools in the district.

While every effort will be made to ensure school starts on time in August, we have to be prepared should there be unforeseen construction delays. Should this occur, it may be necessary to push the first day of school back from Tuesday, August 20, in which case a calamity day would be used. Please know that any change to the start of school schedule will be communicated to parents as soon as possible.

I realize that these changes may be inconvenient for some families, and I appreciate your support and flexibility in this matter. Looking ahead, I know the media center and classroom renovations will provide a nice refresh of our learning spaces for students and staff for years to come.
