Dear Parents,

Throughout the school year, teachers have been preparing students for Ohio's State Tests, which will be administered on the following dates:

- **Wednesday, April 17:** English Language Arts Test, Part 1 (All Grades)
- **Thursday, April 18:** English Language Arts Test, Part 2 (All Grades)
- **Thursday, May 2:** Math Test, Part 1 (All Grades/Subjects)
- **Friday, May 3:** Math Test, Part 2 (All Grades/Subjects)
- **Tuesday, May 7:** Grade 8 Science Test, Parts 1 & 2

On days when assessments are given, we will have a special bell schedule to accommodate an uninterrupted block of time for students to complete testing. The assessments will be administered during the first part of the day using Chromebooks. On test days, it is important for students to arrive on time to school with their fully-charged Chromebooks. Students who are tardy will not be allowed to enter classrooms once testing has begun.

It is extremely important for students to be in attendance on test days. Students not in attendance will complete testing during a make up window.
