- attend training sessions.
- work at least one six (6) hour shift per week.
- always wear his/her uniform while on duty - Zoo Crew shirt & your own khaki shorts or pants.

Computers are used by the women to practice work skills and for use in school, and are also a great addition to a new home when a participant is reunited with her children.
