## 2021 AP EXAM INFORMATION

### 2021 Updates

Orange High School will administer in-person paper/pencil Advanced Placement Exams from May 3 - May 17, 21, and 25. Preparations will be made so that all students have at least 6 foot spacing during testing. At home digital exams will be administered on May 19, 20, and 26th. Please see the schedule for all below.

### Exam Start Times

Students are required to arrive by 7:30 a.m. for morning AP exams and by 11:30 a.m. for afternoon exams. When you arrive in the testing room, please place all personal belongings in the designated area. **Directions will begin promptly at 7:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.** After directions have been read, no students will be permitted to enter the testing room. They will be sent to class. There are no make-up exams unless there is a serious medical reason which must meet requirements set by The College Board. Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. Exams typically end prior to the end time listed on the AP exam chart. Afternoon exams may finish as late as 4 p.m. Your teacher can advise you on specific exam timing. If you are in a spring sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation and make arrangements accordingly.

### What to Bring on the day of your AP Exam

- ✓ Several sharpened #2 pencils with erasers for all multiple choice answer sheets—no mechanical pencils
- ✓ Black or dark blue pens for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams
- ✓ A watch (without an alarm) for pacing yourself
- ✓ A ruler or straightedge if you are taking an AP Physics exam
- ✓ Up to two approved calculators (Check [www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators](http://www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators) for a list of approved calculators.)
- ✓ Hand sanitizer is allowed to be kept under your desk

**Do NOT bring to the exam...** electronic devices, books, dictionaries, notes, rulers or straightedges (except as noted), compasses, scratch paper, a watch with an alarm, photographic equipment, computers or calculators (except as noted), correction fluid/tape, highlighters, colored pencils, food or drinks (except in the break area), or clothing with subject-related information.

### Lunch

Students taking AP exams during the afternoon sessions will need to eat prior to their exams. Please let your teachers know in advance if you need to make arrangements to eat earlier than normal.

### To Do:

- Read the AP Exam Terms and Conditions found at [cb.org/apexamterms](http://cb.org/apexamterms). You will need to acknowledge and agree to these terms on the day of your exam.
- Mark your home and personal calendars to reflect your AP Exam date(s) and time(s).
- Make sure the information in your My AP account is correct and that you are receiving emails from The College Board.
- Seniors - Indicated the college you are attending in the Score Send tab to have your entire AP exam history sent for free to one college or university.
