Dear Orange Schools Families,

Earlier this month, the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) released a Director's Order requiring the reporting and notification regarding COVID-19 cases in Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Per the Order, we request that you call your child's school to report if he or she tests positive for COVID-19. Please call 216-831-8600 followed by the school's extension list here:

- Orange Inclusive Preschool: ext. 5605
- Moreland Hills School: ext. 4603
- Brady Middle School: ext. 3615
- Orange High School: ext. 2611

For Orange Community Education & Recreation programming, please call 216-831-8601.

Within 24 hours of a notification, the district will:

- Complete and submit the Ohio reporting form to the Cuyahoga County Board of Health (CCBH)
- Contact the CCBH via phone or email
- Notify the families of any student who may have been in close contact with the person who tested positive for COVID-19 and share next steps
- Share an informational letter with all families whose children attend school

We will share as much information as possible without disclosing the identification or the person or disclosing protected health information. CCBH will confirm positive results, interview student/parent, and then conduct contact tracing.

As part of the ODH Order, the District website will display a COVID-19 dashboard of the number of known active and cumulative cases among students and staff.
