138 AP Awards Earned by OHS Students

The Orange City School District announced recently that 138 Advanced Placement awards were earned by Orange High School students: 15 students were named National AP Scholars; 62 students qualified for the AP Scholar with Distinction Award; 20 students qualified for the AP Scholar with Honor Award; 39 students qualified for the AP Scholar Award; and 2 student received an AP International Diploma. OHS students have the option to choose from 22 different AP Courses. A total of 80 percent of the AP Exams taken by OHS students received a passing score of 3 or above on a 5-point scale. Using data from the last five years, OHS students consistently performed at a level much higher on Advanced Placement exams than other students across the state and the nation.
