

Excel TECC Timeline

October 29th – Joe Hayes, Guidance Counselor from Excel TECC Career Consortium and Dominic Favazzo, Director of Guidance for Orange Schools, will talk to ALL sophomores in American History Classes about the programs offered through Excel TECC. After the presentation, they will give the students a permission slip form to visit two programs on Opportunity Day (December 6th). Permission slip forms MUST be turned into Orange High School Guidance Office by December 3rd in order for the students to attend Opportunity Day Field Trip. No students will be allowed to attend if permission slip forms are not turned in by that date.

December 6th – OPPORTUNITY DAY FIELD TRIP Students will visit two programs of their choice at the Excel TECC Career Consortium at Mayfield High School. Parents can visit each of the programs at night from 7:00pm – 8:30pm at Mayfield High School. Also, students who missed the field trip can visit with parents on this night.

January 7th- All Excel TECC applications MUST be submitted online by this date.

January 10th, – INTERVIEW DAY. Students, who submitted their applications online, and turned in their Field Trip Permission form for Interview Day, will go to Mayfield High School to interview with their perspective instructors.

First week of February – Students will be notified if they are accepted to an Excel TECC Program. If accepted into an Excel TECC program, students will be called in by their guidance counselor to adjust their classes for the following year and to go over their four-year planners.
