

COVID-19 Hybrid Model - Building Schedule Overview (Fall 2020)

OIP

OIP is already a half-day program. So, when the District returns to a hybrid model, OIP will resume in-person. OIP Schedule

<u>MHS</u>

Moreland will continue to implement the North (PM) cohort (8-10:30) and South (AM) cohort (1-3:30) schedule. Other than the potential of an occasional remote elective, the current schedule will continue when the District makes the transition to the hybrid model.

We are aware of concerns related to the possibility that reconfiguring staff to accommodate both in-person and remote learners may result in some students needing to change home room teachers, particularly in grades K-3. While this is possible, we will accommodate teachers and parents as much as possible to minimize this occurrence. If this occurs, please know that our teachers will work together to make this as smooth as possible, making your child feel welcome.

BMS

Brady will continue with the current bell schedule. However, using video conferencing via Zoom or Google Meets, students in the cohorts will be connected synchronously whether at home or in-person. Therefore, original concerns over lost instructional time in the event of transitioning to the hybrid model have been addressed. The South (originally AM) cohort students will be in-person while their North (originally PM) cohort classmates at home join remotely, and vice-versa in the afternoon, with the North cohort in-person and the South classmates joining remotely. This will allow lessons to be delivered in a split block of instructional time, with the extended mid day break still in place for lunch and personalized learning time. Students whose parents elect remote learning will continue as they currently do.

<u>OHS</u>

The high school will continue with <u>a lengthened version of the current schedule</u>. The school day will be lengthened to align with the District start & end times as well as to increase instructional time. Using video conferencing via Zoom or Google Meets, students in the cohorts will be connected synchronously whether at home or in-person. Furthermore, to address concerns that older students may be likely to contract and transmit COVID-19 more readily than younger students, the OHS cohorts will attend weekly instead of daily. So, the South (originally AM) cohort of students will attend <u>a week of full days</u> while their North (originally PM) classmates join them from home via video conferencing. Then, the following week, the North cohort will attend a full week in-person while the South classmates sign in from home. This will limit exposure to half of the students on any given week at OHS. Students who remain in Remote learning will attend their classes all from home, following the slightly lengthened schedule.
