- **Teacher Assignments:** If your child has a new teacher assignment based on your registration, you will receive an email with this information soon. Teachers will be reaching out to new students to assist with their transition from remote to in- person school.

- **In-person Schedules** - Teachers will be sharing schedules with students/families as we move closer to March 1.
- **Recess** - Our recess blocks will be divided into approximately 5 zones. Students will be assigned a different zone by classroom each day.
- **Lunches at MHS** - There has been changes to our original lunch plan at MHS. We will be utilizing our cafes and classroom spaces to ensure more distancing between students. Approximately half the grade will be assigned in the cafe and the other half will be spread out in grade level wing classrooms for lunch. Classes are assigned to these different spaces based on Orange and Black weeks so all students will have an opportunity to experience the cafe. Students in the cafe will be seated two at a table with plexiglass dividers. Students in classrooms will have an assigned seat with a tri-fold plexiglass divider. All students will have a disposable placement to enjoy their lunch. All spaces will be disinfected after lunch. We encourage our families to take advantage of the free lunch that is offered to all students at MHS. For those students who choose to pack, the lunch must be completely disposable. We will monitor and evaluate these practices over time.
- **Bus Riders** - Transportation will be mailing postcards with your student's pick-up time and bus number.

- **Hand Sanitizing/Washing** - We have many hand sanitizing stations throughout the building including one at each classroom door. Students are asked to use hand sanitizer and/or wash their hands:
 - Before entering the classroom
 - When exiting the classroom.
 - Before eating lunch
 - After eating lunch
 - Before recess
 - After recess
 - After using the restroom

- **Picture Day and Supply Pick-Up for Remote Students February 26th** - Remote students are invited in for picture day and to pick up supplies on February 26th between 10:45 and 12:15 using the following schedule.
 - 10:45 - Last name A - D - **IMPORTANT**: Due to dismissal, do not arrive before this time.
 - 11:15 - Last name E - K
 - 11:45 - Last name L - R
 - 12:15 - Last name S - Z
 - We are asking parents to drop off their child at the front loop. A staff member will be there to assist your child into the building and then to the gym for his/her picture. The student will enter through the Cafe 2 door and will use hand sanitizer upon arrival. Students must wear a mask, but can remove it for their picture.

 - Parents will then park their car on the playground and enter the bridge doors where a staff member will locate the student's supply bag. The parent will then be asked to wait out in the foyer or under the overhang. A staff member will walk your child from the gym to the bridge doors to meet you there.
