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Quick reference to student Code of Conduct addendum for the 2020-2021 school year..

Face Mask Policy - (8450.01)

When deemed necessary by the Superintendent or the Board of Education all students may be required to wear face masks/coverings.

Use of Mask/Face Covering Cloth face coverings/ masks should:

- A. fully cover the mouth, nose, and chin;
- B. fit snugly against the side of the face so there are no gaps;
- C. not create difficulty breathing while worn;
- D. be held securely through either a tie, elastic, etc. to prevent slipping.

If face masks/coverings are required, and no exception is applicable, students shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct/Student Discipline Code. In accordance with policies of the Board and/or may be reassigned by the Superintendent to an online/virtual learning environment if the Superintendent determines that reassignment is necessary to protect the health and safety of the student or others.

Due Process

To ensure that students receive due process, attempts will be made to contact the student and parent or guardian via phone and/or email to set up a face-to-face meeting either in person or virtually to provide the student with due process prior to issuing any school consequences or disciplinary action.

If a parent refuses to avail their student to the administration for questioning, then the administration will note such and continue processing the concern.

Student Code of Conduct

(Please note that the Student Code of Conduct is still in full force during remote learning. If contradictions arise due to remote learning, administrators will use their discretion to resolve them.)

Academic Integrity

The same standards and consequences of academic integrity that apply to a classroom setting will also apply in a virtual and/or hybrid setting.

Attendance

Student attendance hours are a requirement of the State of Ohio, even during remote learning time. We are therefore obligated to report daily and period attendance.

Bullying & Harassment

The same standards and consequences of bullying, harassment, and intimidation that apply to a school setting will also apply in a virtual and/or hybrid setting.

Protection of Student Privacy

Although students in class may be incidentally viewable or audible on the livestream or recorded lesson, FERPA requires that any streams or recordings not be shared with anyone not registered for a given class.
